

Colorado Lions Camp MED CHECK-IN PROCEDURE

Please bring the following three items with you:

1. All medication, vitamins and supplements **MUST** be pre-poured/prepackaged in a medication cassette/med-minder box by a pharmacist, parent/caregiver, or agency. See pictures below. **Please note:** nonprescription, dietary supplements and homeopathic remedies will **NOT** be given at camp unless prescribed by a physician. Pre-pour a six-day supply of medicine with your camper only. The camper's name must be clearly marked on each med-minder box that is checked-in.

2. Send the original prescription bottle(s) and/or bubble pack(s), showing the current prescription information. Each prescription needs to contain one pill inside the original container (this includes vitamin and homeopathic supplements) and will be used for verification purposes. These will be returned when your camper is checked out on Friday. Please do not send the entire bottle(s) of non-prescription medicine and/or supplements.

All medication brought to camp **MUST** be verified by a physician in writing with all medications, dosage, and times listed on the camper medical health form or the healthcare staff will refuse to administer it. The information from the doctor must match the medication that has been poured. Any med changes made to the medical form **AFTER** it has been submitted to camp will need to have new orders faxed to the camp nurse documenting those changes. This is for the safety of your camper.

3. A signed liability release statement **MUST** be signed by the caregiver/parent/agency who poured the medication and given to the camp nurse at the time of check-in. The liability statement will be enclosed in the camper acceptance packet.
